GENERALISED SCHEDULE FOR A BATHROOM RENOVATION

To assist you in understanding the realities of how a Bathroom Renovation is planned, below is a generalised schedule of what happens in what order. A few important points to consider are;

- There are periods between steps where you will not have trades onsite.
- To keep your costs down, when we quote and scope your job we allow for the most efficient use of trades. For example, the plumber will only attend once to connect plumbing fittings and fixtures unless negotiated prior.
- This schedule can be impacted by 'Unforeseen Circumstances' which can include but not limited to, issues that might arise once demolition has been done which may expose water or termite damage that needs rectifying.
- All our projects are unique to the scope of works required to finish, so the below schedule can differ job to job.

STEP 1	Rip out (one day per room). Includes disconnection of electrical & plumbing to room
STEP 2	Rough in walls
STEP 3	Prepare walls for fixtures
STEP 4	Screed flooring
STEP 5	Sheet walls as required. Replace cornice or ready for square set as required
STEP 6	Waterproofing of floor & walls as required
STEP 7	Finish waterproofing floor & walls as required
STEP 8	Tiling of floors & walls
STEP 9	Grouting of tiles & silicone
STEP 10	Fit off all fixtures
STEP 11	Shower screen ordered/site check measure
STEP 12	Electrical & Plumbing reconnection
STEP 13	Shower screen installation
STEP 14	Practical Completion

VANITIES / CABINETRY MIRROR COSTS

Off-the-shelf vanities and cabinetry come in standard sizing, so unless your bathroom re-design adheres to these standards, custom options are ideal. TILING COSTS

Tiles are an important element of your bathroom renovation and the choices are extensive. FITTINGS / FIXTURES COSTS

Cheap materials may not last as long as high quality items. Fittings & fixtures will determine the overall aesthetic of a bathroom. Where a freestanding bath and wall hung toilet can be expensive, they attribute to the overall feel of luxury. While we offer selections to suit many budgets, we strongly advise against using cheap materials as these may not last as long as high quality items.



TRADE COSTS

We have access to all trades required. We work with fixed pricing so you are not required to pay trades separately or obtain your own trades. For your typical bathroom you will need demolition, installation, electrical, plumbing, waterproofing plastering and tiling. Other trades that you may need could be a painter and glazier. Trade costs vary depending on multiple circumstances including but not limited to size, plumbing location, floor removal and design.






BUILDING COSTS
